



# HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

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## HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The high school scholarship program recognizes and encourages motivated high school seniors to build a better future by pursuing a career-focused higher education in the fields of their choice. Each scholarship award will contribute directly to the tuition for the program selected by the recipient. An award of \$1,500 is limited to one senior per high school or two seniors at high schools with a population of more than 400 seniors.

### Terms and Conditions

To qualify for the high school scholarship, an applicant:

- must be a 2012 high school senior or 2012 GED recipient
- must be enrolled in a Redstone College degree or diploma program (certificate programs and employee waivers are not eligible)
- must have a cumulative grade point average of (CGPA) 2.5 or be recommended by a high school educator, counselor, administrator, community leader or employer
- must meet all admissions requirements to Redstone as outlined in the current college catalog

Should the number of scholarship applicants exceed the number of established potential scholarships per high school, the scholarship awards will be determined by an independent review panel.

### Application Requirements

*(Please read carefully.)*

Prospective students may obtain a scholarship application from a Redstone College admissions representative or by downloading an application from the Redstone College web site at [redstone.edu/highschool](http://redstone.edu/highschool).

1. Scholarship application—all information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant; an email address is required for notification of receipt.
2. High school transcript—the most current available transcript at the time of application must be submitted and must state the current cumulative grade point average (CGPA).
3. Eligibility—Applicant may retain eligibility by submitting a letter of recommendation from a high school educator, counselor, administrator, community leader or the student's employer. The letter of recommendation must be typed or written in ink on school or company letterhead and must display the name, address, phone number and email address of the person making the recommendation.

### Submission Procedure

All materials and supplementary documents must be submitted together in one envelope; applicant should keep copies of all materials. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. The envelope must be received by scholarship administration on or before the deadline printed on the application. Application packets will be accepted later than the deadline only if postmarked at least five business days prior to the deadline.

### Redstone Scholarship Distribution

For a student to receive full eligibility, and be eligible for the Redstone scholarship disbursement, he/she must complete at least 60 percent of the term of study. If a student withdraws after the 60 percent time frame, he/she will receive a pro-rated amount of the scholarship based on the percentage of tuition charged.

If a student receives multiple scholarships (including Imagine America, high school, and any other new-student or continuing education scholarship), disbursements will be paid consecutively and not concurrently for a maximum disbursement of \$500 per term in total for all scholarships awarded.
